## Nahum

## 1 - Nahum 1—Who Can Endure God's Anger?

From the book of Jonah, what do we know about Nineveh? Now, it was the capital of Assyrian rule who had already overtaken Israel (the North) into captivity – and threatening Judah (the South). Nahum means "comfort" – how was God's message "comforting"?

## 2 - Nahum 2—God Says, "I Am Against You!"

Where is Jesus in this chapter? How is this a mockery of Assyria – symbolized as a lion? 1 Peter 5:8-9 pictures the devil as a roaring lion – how might we also see "comfort" in our spiritual battles in these verses?

## 3 - Nahum 3—Judgment Deserved

How powerful had Nineveh become? What does God say He will do to Nineveh? Note 1:3 again - how does this chapter reveal this truth? The last verse is the destruction of Nineveh! What does this say, and how does this "comfort" us concerning our spiritual enemies?
