What changed Paul and others (and us)? How is what Paul writes a "trustworthy statement"?

Titus 3:9-15—Do What Is Good (Take 2)

What are examples of "doing good"? Note how v.10 gives an answer to question of how to silence rebellious people. Who were some of "our people"? Who would "our people" be for us today? How can we "do good" for them?
