**HOLY COMMUNION**

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at Holy Cross in the confident, joyful confession that it is the true body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ under the bread and wine, instituted by Christ Himself for us Christians to eat and to drink (Matthew 26:26-29).

Personal examination, prior to participation, is encouraged by the Scriptures (1 Corinthians 11:28), and might include these questions:

- Am I a sinner?
- Am I sorry for my sins?
- Do I believe Jesus gives me His body and blood together with the bread and wine for the forgiveness of sins?
- Do I intend by the Power of the Holy Spirit to amend my sinful life?

As members of the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, we believe the Scriptures affirm that our participation in Holy Communion is an expression of our unity in faith.

If you desire to participate and are not a member of the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, or if you have questions or concerns about the meaning of this sacrament or confession of this congregation, please talk with our pastor or one of the elders. ## **Holy Cross Lutheran School's 60th Anniversary**

We praise God for sixty years of blessings at Holy Cross Lutheran School! This weekend, many former principals, teachers, and alumni are joining us in celebrating sixty years of providing a Christ-centered education at Holy Cross.

In November of 1958, Pastor Martin Hartenberger (pastor from 1955-1971) and the Holy Cross congregation of 525 members passed a resolution to build a Christian day school at 9th and Oliver. Classes began on September 8, 1959 in the old Adams schoolhouse with an enrollment of 105 students in eight grades. The following year, the staff expanded to six teachers and a kindergarten class was added.

Plans were soon made to build an education building on the same property as the church. A Service of Dedication was held for the new school on March 12, 1961. A Parish Activity Center, which included a gym, lockers, and a small kitchen, was added in 1976. Holy Cross opened its first Preschool at 933 North Oliver in September 1991.

In 1992, a study was commissioned to consider the future of the church and school. It was recommended that Holy Cross relocate, and in 1994, the congregation adopted the resolution to relocate near Central and Greenwich Road. The school, gymnasium, offices and youth room were built in the first phase of construction. Classes began in the new facility on February 24, 1997.

The school has continued to grow and thrive under the leadership of many dedicated principals and teachers over these 60 years. Holy Cross holds to a high standard of academics while also giving children a strong spiritual foundation. Holy Cross has the reputation in the community of preparing our students to excel academically in high school. Holy Cross students also have many opportunities to grow through art, music, athletics, and extra-curricular and fellowship events.

We praise God for the blessings of the past and for His continued guidance and blessings in the future!
