November 1 - 6, 2020

SUNDAY, NOV. 1 (ALL SAINTS' DAY)

MONDAY, NOV. 2

Pray for healing in our land; from racial tensions, violence against communities and law enforcement, and the deep divisions growing like cancer in our cities and neighborhoods.

2 Chronicles 7:14 “If My people, who are called by My name, will humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, that I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.”

TUESDAY, NOV. 3 (ELECTION DAY)

Pray that God will help you and those in authority to be His “faithful ones”; speaking the truth in love. (Ephesians 4:15)

Proverbs 2:1-6 “My child, if you accept (God’s) words and store up (His) commands within you, turning your ear to wisdom and applying your heart to understanding, and if you call out for insight and cry aloud for understanding, and if you look for it as for silver and search for it as for hidden treasure, then you will understand the fear of the LORD and find the knowledge of God. For the LORD gives wisdom, and from His mouth come knowledge and understanding.

WEDNESDAY, NOV. 4

Give thanks for the freedoms and privilege of holding elections in our country; praying for those who live under authoritarian governments with no freedoms.

Jeremiah 29:7, 11-13 “Seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile... Then you will call upon Me and come and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. You will seek Me and find Me when you seek Me with all your heart.”
