Personal devices for the hearing impaired are available from an usher. **AS WE GATHER** When Jesus uses the image of the vine and speaks of vineyards, He is choosing something very familiar to His hearers. Viticulture is well known around the world. More than eighteen million acres worldwide is used for growing grapes—from Panama to Tajikistan to Zimbabwe! Today, the cultivation of vineyards is still an important agricultural component in both Israel and the Jordan, lands where Jesus walked and taught. Life in the vineyard is vital! As branches grafted to the Vine that is Christ, we are vitalized by His power. As we worship, God's life-supporting power infuses us! God bless and grant us to continue growing!

HOLY COMMUNION

The Lord's Supper is celebrated in the joyful, confident confession that it is the true body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ under the bread and wine, instituted by Christ Himself for us Christians to eat and to drink (Matt. 26:26-29). Personal examination, prior to participation, is encouraged by the Scriptures (1 Cor. 11:28), and might include these questions:

- Am I a sinner?
- Am I sorry for my sins?
- Do I believe Jesus gives me His body & blood together with the bread & wine for the forgiveness of sins?
- Do I intend by the Power of the Holy Spirit to amend my sinful life?

As members of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod (LCMS), we believe the Scriptures affirm that our participation in Holy Communion is an expression of our unity in faith. If you desire to participate and are not an LCMS member, please call the Church Office to speak to one of our pastors. You may also speak to a pastor or Elder before the worship service. If you are unable to speak to someone before the service, we invite you to come forward for a blessing. Please fold your arms across your chest as the pastor comes to you to indicate that you wish to receive a blessing.

HOLY CROSS LUTHERAN SCHOOL

The Accreditation Team completed their visit for K-8 this week. Their visit was very positive and encouraging. We will receive dual accreditation from COGNIA and NLSA. In addition, we will receive accreditation through the state of Kansas in the fall. Highlights from the visit:

• The team visited with staff, parents and students.

• The team appreciated the warm hospitality.

• The importance of Jesus was evident from K to 8 children, teachers, staff and parents. One Kindergarten student told the team that Jesus is the main reason for the school. He noted how important the cross on the bell tower was for all to see so those who did not know Jesus would learn about Him.

• The relationship between the church and school received extremely high commendation. The team observed the positive relationships and purpose between church and school. The team only knew of one other church/school in the United States which has such positive connections.

• The team noted the high academic expectations and successes of Holy Cross students.

• The teachers received higher instructional marks compared to other accredited schools' nationwide.

• In summary, they reported that Holy Cross is blessed by staff, school, church, facilities, playgrounds, and beautiful grounds. What to work on? Strategic planning for additional staff as the school continues to grow.
